**between the management of “summer Centres” and the families of the enrolled children
about organizational, sanitation and individual behavior
aimed at limiting the spread of the infection from covid-19**

SUBSCRIBE THE FOLLOWING MUTUAL RESPONSIBILITY AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE ATTENDANCE OF

IN THE “SUMMER CENTRE” MENTIONED ABOVE.

in particular, the parent (or holder of parental responsibility) declares:

- to be aware of the contagion containment measures currently in force;
- that the child, or a cohabitant within the family unit is not subjected to the measure of the quarantine or that it has not tested positive for COVID-19;
- to commit to keep the child at home in the presence of fever (equal to or above 37.5) or other symptoms such as sore throat, nasal congestion, conjunctivitis, loss of smell or taste and promptly inform the pediatrician and the manager of the “Summer Centre” of the onset of symptoms or fever;
- to be aware and accept that the child is subjected to a fever measurement with a non-contact thermometer before entering the Centre and that, in the event of a fever equal to or greater than 37.5 ° or the presence of other symptoms mentioned above, will not be admitted to the “Summer Centre” and will remain under its responsibility;
- to be aware and accept that, in the event of a fever (equal to or greater than 37.5) or other symptoms (among those listed above), the managing body provides immediate isolation of the child or adolescent and immediately inform the doctor / pediatrician of free choice and the family members. The doctor / pediatrician of free choice will immediately contact the Department of Public Health (DSP) in order to programming the nasal-pharyngeal swab and to arrange the procedures and precautions to be taken while waiting for further diagnostic investigations. The precautions include the immediate removal of the symptomatic person from the school, by the parent or other responsible adult.
- to be aware that the child will have to comply with the hygienic-sanitary indications inside the Centre;
- to have been adequately advised by the organizers of the “Summer Centre” about all the organizational and hygienic sanitary provisions regarding safety and the containment of the risk of spreading the infection from Covid-19 and, in particular about:
 - rules for access and exit from the “Summer Centre”;
 - prohibition to enter the school and the surrounding areas, except for situations of proven emergency, while activities are ongoing and in the presence of children;
- to commit to adopt, even in the times and places of the day when the child is not at the “Summer Centre”, maximum precautionary conduct regarding the risk of contagion;
- to be aware that the resumption of interaction activities, albeit controlled, does not allow the risk of contagion to be zeroed, and that this risk can be minimized through the scrupulous and rigorous observance of the precautionary and safety measures envisaged by specific protocols. For this reason, it is important to observe extreme caution even outside of the context of the “Summer Centre”.

in particular, the management declares:

- to have provided, at the time of registration, detailed information regarding each organizational and hygienic health device adopted to contain the spread of the infection from Covid-19 and to undertake, during the period of attendance at the “Summer Centre”, to communicate any changes to the provisions ;
- that, for the organization of the “Summer Centre”, employs adequately trained personnel on all aspects relating to the current regulations on the organization of summer services, in particular on the sanitary proce-

- dures to combat the spread of the infection. The staff is committed to scrupulously observe each prescription health and hygiene and to be on duty only in the absence of any symptoms referable to Covid-19;
- to undertake to carry out the triage procedures at the entrance and to adopt all the hygienic-sanitary prescriptions provided for by the current legislation, including the provisions regarding the social distancing;
 - not to promote activities involving contact between different groups of children in which the “Summer Centre” is organized;
 - to strictly and scrupulously comply - in the case a child or an adult have been infected by Covid-19 attending the “Summer Centre” - at any disposal of the local health authority;

The signing of this agreement commits the parties to respect it in good faith. From a legal point of view, it does not release the parties who subscribe to it from any responsibility in the event of non-compliance with the regulations relating to the containment of the Covid-19 epidemic, with the ordinary workplace safety regulations, and with the Guidelines for safe management of organized social and play opportunities for children and adolescents in phase 2 of the COVID-19 emergency, and with the related Regional Protocol for recreational activities and “Summer Centres” for children and adolescents.
